The Association of New Brunswick Licensed Practical Nurses (ANBLPN) was first created in 1965 as the Association of New Brunswick Registered Nursing Assistants. They became the regulatory body in 1977 when the Registered Nursing Assistant (RNA) Act was proclaimed. In 2002 the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) Act was proclaimed and RNAs became LPNs.

### Association of New Brunswick Licensed Practical Nurses

have met all requirements for licensure as an LPN in New York State except for taking the National Council License Examination for Licensed Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN). A limited permit holder (called a "Graduate Practical Nurse" or "GPN") can temporarily practice nursing under RN supervision at the health care facility noted on the limited permit.
